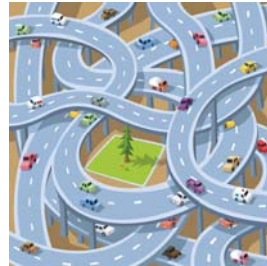

ABOUT THE SPEAKERS

Steven Deck, AICP

Steven Deck, AICP is the Senior Supervising Planner for Parsons Brinckerhoff. Mr. Deck has 25 years of experience in transportation planning and policy, all levels of NEPA analyses, a wide range of municipal planning efforts, and secondary and cumulative impact issues. He has been responsible for the oversight of planning analyses for a variety of types of projects and has extensive expertise in the area of community/public involvement. He has provided training in the areas of transportation impact fees, secondary and cumulative impact analyses, comprehensive and regional planning, and the transportation project development process. He also has experience as the chairman of a municipal planning commission, providing him with an understanding of local planning issues and procedures. He currently acts as the office manager for PB's Harrisburg, PA office and manages the PennDOT Planning Services and Implementation and Aviation/Rail Freight open-end contracts with about a dozen active work orders.

Angela Watson, AICP

Angela Watson, AICP is currently a Senior Transportation Planner with Parsons Brinckerhoff, Inc. Prior to joining PB, Angela worked with the PA Department of Transportation as a Transportation Planning Specialist Supervisor and was responsible for managing the Department's land use related initiatives and policies. Angela received her Bachelor of Science in Geography with a concentration in Urban and Regional Development from Penn State University, and anticipates her Master of Science degree in Community and Regional Planning from Temple University in 2010. She was the Zoning Administrator for the City of Harrisburg prior to being employed with PennDOT, and currently serves on the City's Zoning Hearing Board.

SESSION DESCRIPTION

Planning for transportation and circulation is one of the primary roles of local government as well as one of the hardest tasks for them to complete. For their most recent handbook that addressed planning, PennDOT worked with numerous stakeholders to develop a handbook for municipalities and counties on how to create comprehensive plans that have a strong link between land use planning and transportation planning. The handbook also includes summaries of over 30 best practice techniques from Pennsylvania communities. The training will review this handbook in detail.

Additionally, the training will review the other handbooks in PennDOT's series on transportation planning, which have addressed traffic noise, access management, transportation impact fees, and smart transportation. Currently under development is a handbook on local implementation tools, which will also be discussed.

The training will focus on land use and transportation planning in comprehensive plans, but will also address key points in the other handbooks, including the local implementation tools handbook. Attendees will be provided with a full view of the PennDOT resources available to them, and leave with ideas – and examples - to improve transportation planning in their communities on a number of transportation related issues.
